- **ALL** classroom activities, tests, quizzes and assignment due dates are identified on the monthly calendars on my website www.brannanhealthandpe.weebly.com. *If a student is absent they are expected to reference these calendars so that they know what they missed in class and can print off any homework that was assigned.*
- **ALL** worksheets and/or homework instructions can be printed from the website www.brannanhealthandpe.weebly.com. *If a student loses a handout or worksheet it is expected that they print out another copy on their own.*
- **ALL** homework must be word processed using 12 point font, double spacing and normal margins (unless otherwise instructed to do so).
- If students do not have a computer at home, they have access to computers in our media center. If printing is a challenge, students must either save their work on a travel drive and bring it into school to be printed or email their work to me directly at amy.brannan@d300.org.
- Students should contact me during my office hours or at amy.brannan@d300.org if they need help or have questions regarding homework. All special situations regarding homework will be considered on a case-by-case basis. Homework is collected at the beginning of class on the day it is due. Late homework will be graded as follows:
 - 1 day late – reduced 10%
 - 2 days late – reduced 25%
 - 1 week late – reduced 50%
 - After 1 week (but before the Unit Test) – reduced 75%
 - Any homework that is still missing after the Unit Test will be graded as a ZERO.
- Students that are absent on the day an assignment is due are expected to turn their work in at the beginning of class upon their return to class.
- Students that are absent on the day homework is assigned will be allowed 2 class days (per the student handbook) extension to complete their work.
