- Short term physical/mental effects (at least 5)
- Long term physical/mental effects (at least 5)
- Provide information on any medical uses for the drug (many of the drugs we study were legal at one time)
- References: At least 3 total. You MUST use 1 article from Teen Health and Wellness, 1 Book, and 1 of the websites provided below. Works cited must be in MLA format.
